ORDINANCE NO. 2012-**

**SETTING FORTH FUNDING ALLOCATIONS FROM THE COMMUNITY
REVITALIZATION GRANT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, Lehigh County has created the Community Revitalization Grant Program which has as its purpose the provision of monetary support for the promotion of economic development and the well-being of the community; and

WHEREAS, various community agencies have made requests of Lehigh County for funding from these initiatives; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Community and Economic Development has made recommendations regarding the organizations which should receive assistance; and

WHEREAS, the following organizations would receive funding in the total amounts indicated below:

WHEREAS, Ordinance approval of grants made outside of the budgetary grants process is required pursuant to the County of Lehigh Grants Policy.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY
THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF LEHIGH,
PENNSYLVANIA, THAT:**

1. The foregoing WHEREAS clauses are incorporated herein as if set forth in their entirety.
2. The grants to the Borough of Coopersburg, Whitehall Township and Emmaus Main Street Partners, set forth herein, are hereby approved. Disbursal of the funds shall be contingent upon execution of the grant agreements.
3. The proper officers and other personnel of Lehigh County are hereby authorized and empowered to take all such further action, including any necessary transfers of funds, and execute additional documents as they may deem appropriate to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.
4. The County Executive shall distribute copies of this Ordinance to the proper offices and other personnel of Lehigh County whose further action is required to achieve the purpose of this Ordinance.
5. Any Ordinance or part of any Ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby released insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.
6. This Ordinance shall become effective in ten (10) days after enactment.
