## **ALWAYS CALL AHEAD TO LEARN ABOUT SITE-SPECIFIC PRACTICES**

**1 - ARRIVE WITH A CLEAN VEHICLE  
- INTERIOR AND EXTERIOR -  
AND ADEQUATE PPE  
LEAVE WINDOWS CLOSED UPON  
ARRIVAL**



**2 - PARK IN THE DESIGNATED  
PARKING AREA, EITHER  
INSIDE OR OUTSIDE OF THE  
PERMETER BUFFER AREA (PBA)**



**3 - PUT ON DISPOSABLE  
BOOTS BEFORE EXITING THE  
VEHICLE - STREET SHOES  
SHOULD NEVER TOUCH THE  
GROUND**



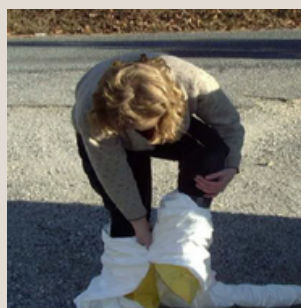
**4 - IF CROSSING A LINE OF  
SEPARATION (LOS), PUT ON  
CLEAN OR DISPOSABLE  
HEADCOVER, COVERALLS, AND  
A SECOND PAIR OF BOOTS**



**5 - IF INTERACTING WITH ANIMALS,  
USE GLOVES OR HAND SANITIZER  
BEFORE GOING INTO ANIMAL  
LOCATIONS. PROPERLY FITTED  
FACEMASK/RESPIRATOR, AND EYE  
PROTECTION MAY BE  
RECOMMENDED**



**6 - AFTER YOUR VISIT IS  
COMPLETE, PPE SHOULD BE  
CAREFULLY REMOVED AS YOU  
CROSS THE LOS AND/OR PBA,  
AND PUT IN A TRASH BAG TO  
LEAVE ON PREMISES OR  
DISPOSE OF AFTER YOU LEAVE**



**7 - REMOVE DISPOSABLE  
BOOTS WHEN YOU RETURN TO  
YOUR VEHICLE. PLACE THE  
BOOTIES IN A GARBAGE BAG  
AND SPRAY DISINFECTANT ON  
SHOES--DON'T FORGET THE  
SOLES!**
