## **Pension Fund Update**

2023 ended on a high note with the S&P up 26%. We had a really strong fourth Quarter. We have had a flat start to 2024, with technology continuing to be the driving force behind returns. Total portfolio was up 8.6% in the first quarter of 2024.

## **Asset Allocation**

With quarter ending December 31, 2023, our IPS ending weights are 43.3% domestic equity, 18.0% international equity, 22.1% domestic fixed income, 12.1% alternative stocks and 4.5% cash and equivalents.

# **Historical Cashflow**

Withdrawals since inception have been \$353,631,000. Contributions since inception have been \$176,239,000. The change in market value since inception is \$297,366,0000.

# **Manager Performance**

We are diversified between U.S. and international stocks, bonds, and alternative investments. We are squarely where we intend to be and the fund is healthy. We expect bonds to give us a nice return moving forward. There is still volatility in the market, but we are in good shape.
