10:00am-10:30 – Welcome and introductions

10:30am-11:30am – **Richard Orlemann, Lehigh Mental Health and Judy Stanczak, Office of Aging** will be presenting on the topic of “Systems working in collaboration to more effectively meet the needs of the aging population” They will be discussing when someone should call the mental health office and when they should call the aging office. They will also be discussing how the two offices work together as well as what other services and resources are available in the community.

11:30am – 12:15pm – **Laurie Reichert, Humana Representative** will be presenting “The ABC’s of Medicare”. Become familiar (or review!) with basic components of Medicare, enrollment periods, difference between Medicare Advantage Plans and Medicare Supplements, and understand the coverage gap in Medicare Prescription Drug Plan.
