


Lehigh County System of Care (SOC) Leadership Team

Step 1: Get Involved with the County Leadership Team



Lehigh County has established a System of Care (SOC) Leadership Team- comprised of youth & families who have had, or currently have, involvement with the Lehigh County Department of Human Services Agencies and/or Juvenile Probation. "The System (s)," (as some refer to it,) includes Children & Youth, Intellectual Disabilities, Mental Health, Juvenile Probation, Drug & Alcohol, foster care, and/or other systems in the county. The **GOAL** of this team is to build the bridge between youth, families, and professionals -by sharing your **own experiences** and **making recommendations** to the Lehigh County Department of Human Services on how "the Systems" can improve their services and outcomes for YOU and the upcoming generation of children & families

Youth & Family Driven

- At least half of the Leadership team members is made up of youth and family members, in equal numbers, who are representative of the population of focus
- The Team includes leaders from the County Juvenile Justice, Child Welfare, Behavioral Health, Education and Drug & Alcohol systems
- The Leadership Team meets regularly and makes decisions
- Every member is supported in equal decision-making within its structure
- All members participate in the development and approval of strategic goals, action steps and desired outcomes
