To be seen during walk in hours, you must bring:

- *** Photo identification
- *** Social Security Card (if you do not have your SS card, then please bring something else with your name and address listed on it.)

If you have **INCOME** and do not have services through medical assistance (which may include food stamps, OB/GYN coverage, etc.) you must also bring:

Proof of income:

- *** Current paystub from employer
- *** SSD/SSI letter for the current year – or copy of bank statement
- *** Unemployment compensation statement
- *** Interest or dividends from banking accounts

If your net income is over **\$10,080**, you must also bring:

- *** Doctor/Hospital Bills that are paid or unpaid from within the last year
- *** Pharmacy print out of prescriptions paid for the past year
- *** Child support, alimony
- *** Real Estate tax statement
