Lehigh County Parks Hunting Policy

Hunting policy for Lehigh County Parks is listed below by Park.

Hunting is prohibited at Cedar Creek Parkway East, Cedar Creek Parkway West, Bob Rodale Cycling and Fitness Park, Saylor Park, Troxell-Steckel Park, the D&L Trail maintained by Lehigh County.

Trexler Nature Preserve – Archery hunting only is permitted in posted areas, pursuant to PA Game Commission rules and regulations.

Big Rock – Hunting is permitted, pursuant to PA Game Commission rules and regulations.

Leaser Lake – Hunting is permitted in designated areas, pursuant to PA Game Commission rules and regulations.

Jordan Creek Parkway – A permit issued by the Bureau of Parks and Recreation is required to hunt in posted areas of Jordan Creek Parkway south of Lehnert Road. The permit allows archery hunting only in the designated areas, pursuant to PA Game Commission Rules and Regulations.

Permits are limited and issued on a first come, first served basis to Lehigh County Residents only. They are valid for a single hunting season.

Permits may be obtained at the Parks Office, starting on the day that the PA Game Commission begins to issue tags for the license year. Applicants must appear in person and present their valid hunting license and tags and their PA driver's license at the Parks Office to receive a permit. The driver's license requirement is waived for junior hunters applying for a permit with a parent.

Walking Purchase / Lehigh Mountain Park – Hunting in Walking Purchase Park is pursuant to the ordinances of Salisbury Township. Prospective hunters should contact Salisbury Township and to obtain information about hunting in Walking Purchase Park.
